Comic Relief



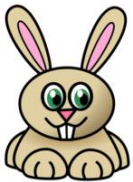
This Friday, 24th, we will be selling cakes at 50p each to support Comic Relief - school uniform is to be worn as usual. Any parents whose

Many thanks to all parents/carers who attended the reading afternoons at school.

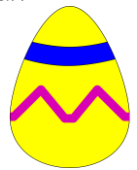
School premises rules
