Class 1 and Class 4 will be open all day as normal

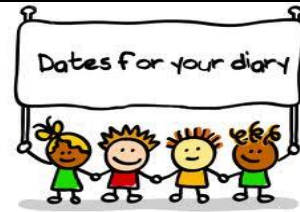
Class 2 and Class 3 will be open until 12.30pm
