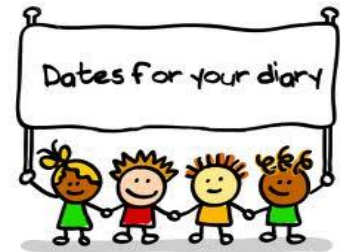


## Homework
