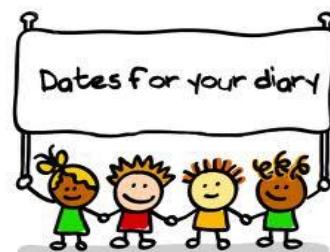


Online Safety
