

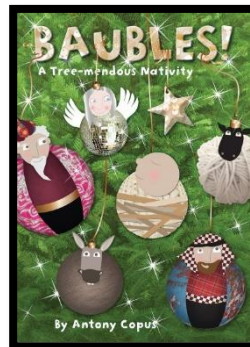

Fundraising

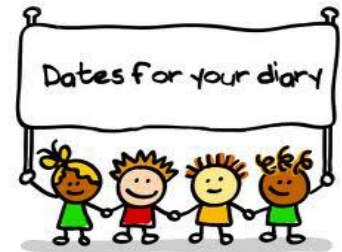
Thank you to everyone who donated to Children in Need and the Poppy Appeal. We raised £75 for Children in Need and £98.86 for the British Legion.

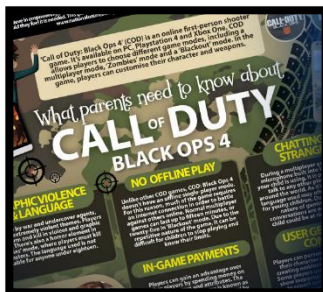

Online Safety:

This week's online safety guide is about the game Call of Duty. I know the pressure parents can be under when your child wants to play the game their friends are playing! 'Call of Duty: Black Ops 4' (COD) is an online first-person shooter game. It's available on PC, Playstation 4 and Xbox One. COD allows players to choose different game modes, including a multiplayer mode, 'Zombies' mode and a 'Blackout' mode. In the game, players can customise their character and weapons.
