This week, I'm sharing a link to the Children's Commissioner report 'Talking to your child about online sexual harassment: A guide for parents.'

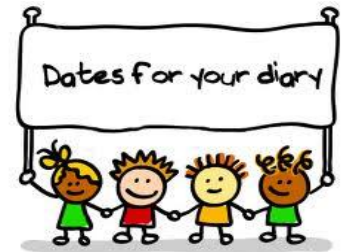
