## Mother's Day Raffle

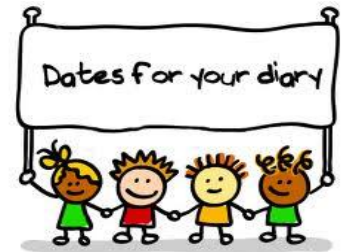
