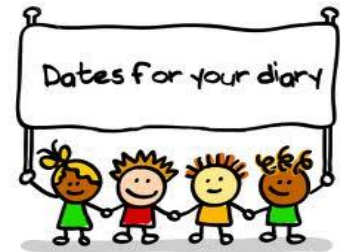


Colour run
