Just a reminder that we are closed on Thursday next week as we are being used as a polling station.

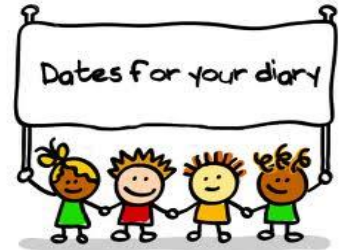
The Great Sunnybrow Family Day Out
