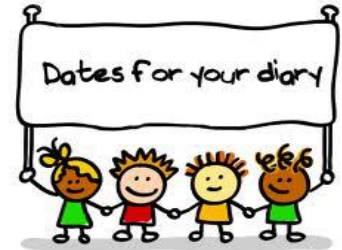


## Online Safety
