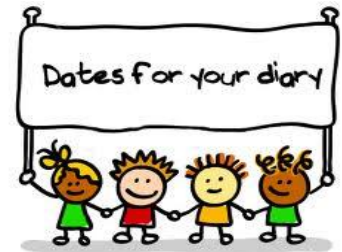

## Safeguarding:

Worried about a child out of school hours?

Unfortunately, pop-up advertising carries with it various online safety risks, as we can never be certain where those links will take us or how legitimate their creators are. These ads can be especially risky for children and young people, who may not yet be able to look at such marketing with a critical eye. However, this week's National Online Safety guide will educate you on pop-ups, their associated risks, and how to safeguard yourself and young people from this phenomenon.

- If a child is in **immediate danger or at risk of immediate harm**, you should contact the **Police on 999**.
- If you are **concerned** about a child you should share your concern with the **First Contact Team on 03000 267 979**.
