**Thursday 18<sup>th</sup>**-Leavers disco. 3.30pm-4.45pm. Please could children bring their party clothes in a named bag.

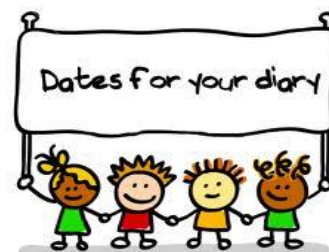
**Friday 19<sup>th</sup>**-Break the rules day. 50p a rule.

For children coming without a family member, could all children have a bag with a towel, waterproof coat and a change of clothing.

For families meeting us at South Shields, we will be parking next to Dunes Soft Play/arcades and should be there by 10.15am. We will then be heading down to the beach. We always go to the beach through the funfair, where the lifeguards are usually stationed.

We will be setting up camp for the day there. We will be sectioning off an area, with each class having a designated space. Throughout the day, we will be going in the sea, having a sandcastle competition, playing tug of war and just having fun. Families are welcome to stay with us or you can head off into South Shields for fun at the fair, the park...just please not the pub! Every child will bring home an ice-cream token on Friday 19<sup>th</sup>. We will pay for the ice-creams at Layla's ice-cream shop in the arcades, right next to the toilet block before you get to the beach walkway. Children can then hand their voucher over to the ladies in the shop to get an ice-cream or ice-lolly.

The bus will be leaving for home at 2pm prompt. We won't be able to wait around as the bus company have other commitments.

We will be going even if light rain is forecast. However, if it is torrential, we will make a decision if the trip is still going ahead and put it on dojo by 8.00am at the latest, so children can then make their way into school.

**Tuesday 23rd-Leavers assembly.** This starts at 1pm. It will include each class's end of year awards and then a section for our lovely Year 6 pupils. School will be closing straight after at 2pm. If you are unable to attend, please could you arrange for your child to be collected from school at 2pm.
