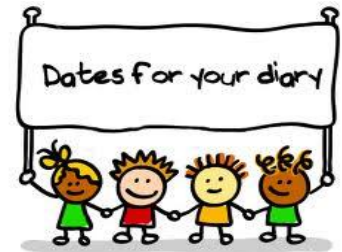
New Uniform Supplier
