a cuppa whilst reading with their children. Thank you to the parents who attended.

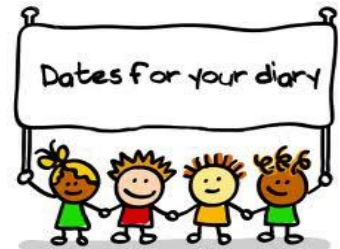


We've still been working incredibly hard in our other lessons too. Class 2 have been learning
