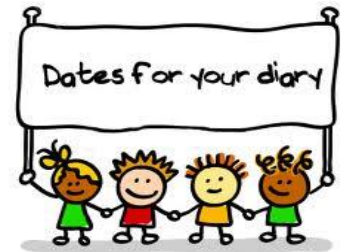
Class 1 have been learning all about St George's Day. The children made their own helmets and the cross of St George.
