

Worried about a child out of school hours?



Tracking devices were designed to help people find lost belongings, but they've also opened the door to worrying forms of misuse. This week's top tips guide explores how Bluetooth trackers like Air Tags and Smart Tags can be misused for stalking, bullying and invading young people's privacy.
