
## Weekly Top Tips:

Children and young people are increasingly turning to social media for mental health advice, but much of what they encounter online is unverified, oversimplified or misleading. This week's National Online Safety guide explores why platforms like TikTok and Instagram have



become go-to sources, and how misuse of clinical language and viral trends can distort children and young people's understanding of mental health.

Aimed at parent and educators, it offers clear, expert-led strategies to counter misinformation. The guide looks at topics such as encouraging open conversations, identifying reliable sources, and strengthening school-home collaboration.
